For the past four summers, Rett's Roost has created a safe, compassionate space where families who have experienced childhood cancer and child loss can find a source of connection with one another.

This past year was our first in Ogunquit, ME, and it truly was a fantastic and memorable summer and fall. We hosted four bereavement retreats at the new location and we are happy to report it is the perfect fit for our programming. Our onsite retreats all hosted four to six families, including our own. For our retreat for families with childhood cancer survivors, we headed north to Duck Puddle Campground, and thanks to its amazing owners, six families had a wonderful experience in fully outfitted cabins on Pemaquid Lake.

We feel really organized as we head into 2019 and are so happy to be able to provide you with this first-of-its-kind annual report. In January, we'll be announcing next year's retreat schedule and opening our new online registration system to families. One big project we have planned for this spring is to erect a yurt on the property that will be used for group and individual therapies during retreats. Behind the scenes, we'll be working with an accounting firm in Portland to establish our first Financial Review. We're also setting our sights on developing a strategic fundraising plan with the hopes of securing more funding from grants and hiring one or two more part-time employees.

Retreats at a Glance



Rett's Roost is committed to offering whole family support in an effort to alleviate the trauma and stress from ongoing medical treatment of a child, and the intense grief that accompanies a child's death. The organization has hosted 50 families on 11 free, intimate, holistic healing retreats.



Retreats take place from May until November at the Rett's Roost "Heart-quarters" in Ogunquit, ME, or a similar beautiful, natural retreat center or campground. Lodging is private and comfortable and the food served is homemade, healthy, and delicious. The organization aims to place together families with similar types of loss and children of similar ages.



Activities include beach outings, nature walks, outdoor family photo sessions, trips to farms, horseback riding, bonfires, and cookouts. Weekend programming is tailored to the interests of each family with specific consideration for the age group of the children attending. Rett's Roost has a dedicated team of volunteers and professionals who provide individual sessions during the retreats, such as talk therapy, art and music therapy, mediumship, massage, reiki, and aromatherapy.

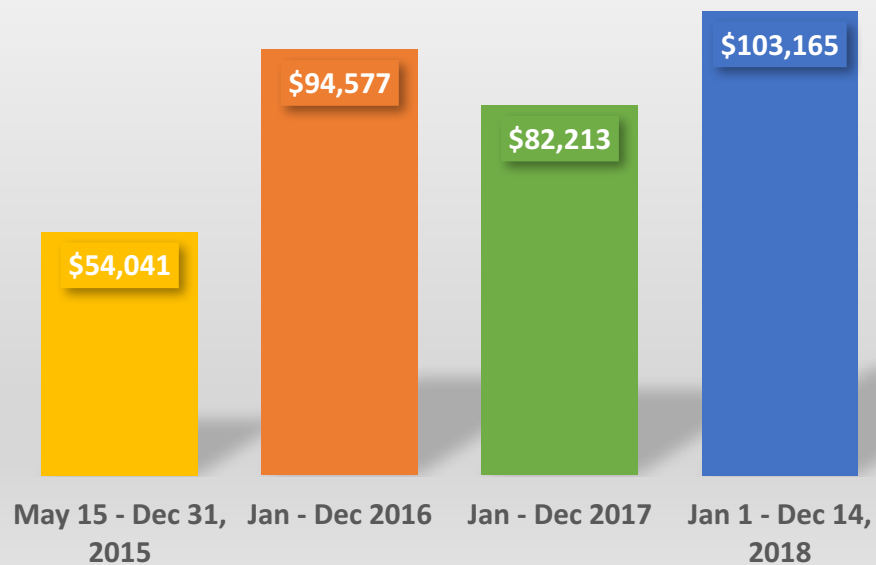

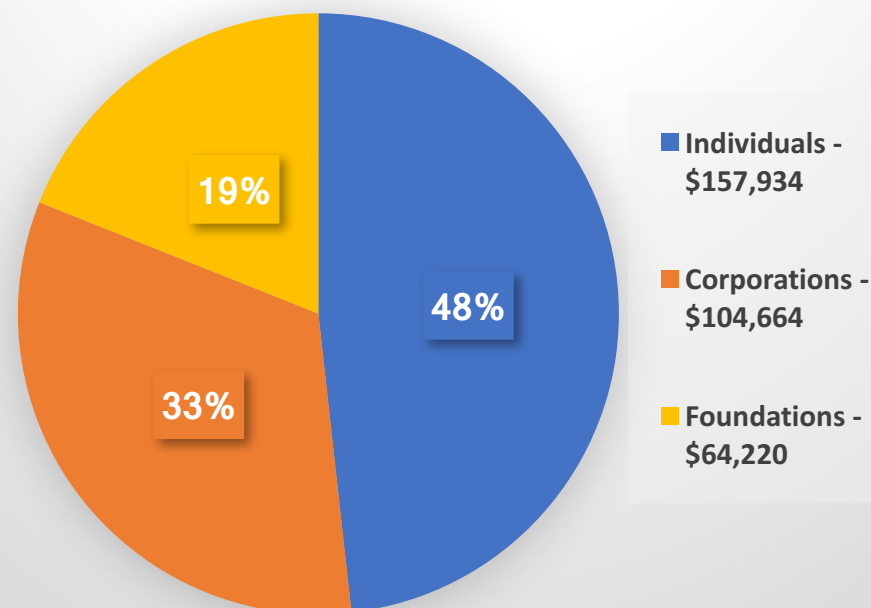

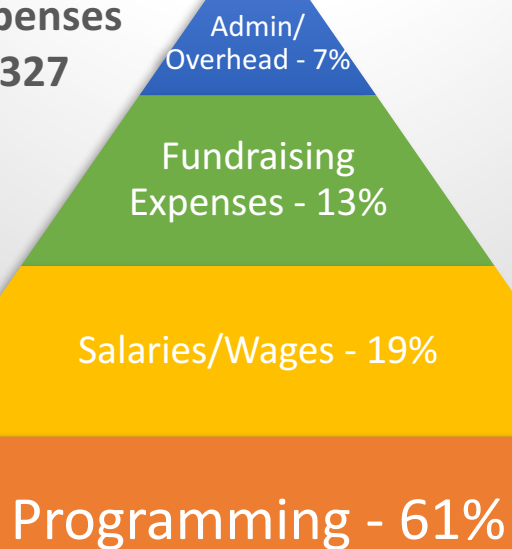
Annual Revenues
